Policy Statement: Selection of Scouts to fill our council contingent to the 2010 National Scout Jamboree

In an effort to assure that all Scouts in the Patriots' Path Council have equal opportunity to enroll in our council contingent for the 2010 National Scout Jamboree, the following policy has been adopted by the council jamboree committee:

Our council allocation is five troops consisting of 36 scouts and four adult leaders for a total of 180 scouts and 20 adult leaders.

1. Pre-registration for scouts desiring to attend the jamboree will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 10th, 2008. Applications for pre-registration will be accepted on a first-come, first served basis between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon at St. Mark Lutheran Church, 100 Harter Road, Morris Township, NJ. Thereafter, applications for pre-registration will be accepted at the Wyatt Scout Shop in Florham Park on a first-come, first-served basis during scheduled scout shop hours. All applications for pre-registration must be accompanied with a \$100 deposit to hold a spot. The \$100 deposit is nonrefundable once the scout is confirmed as a jamboree participant. Scouts on the waiting list who wish to withdrawal their application prior to being confirmed may do so in which case the \$100 deposit will be refunded.
2. No applications will be accepted for any reason before 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 10th, 2008.
3. All applications for pre-registration will be date- and time-stamped upon submission. The purpose of this date- and time-stamp will be to establish the order that applications will be reviewed during the "waves of acceptances" which is described below.
4. Applications for pre-registration will be reviewed according to the following schedule and applicants shall be advised by email when their spot has been confirmed.
 - (a) From May 10th through May 17th, 2008, the first 4 scouts from each troop to sign-up, subject to established quotas by district, shall be confirmed. All other applicants shall be waitlisted.
 - (b) From May 19th through May 24th, 2008, remaining scouts from each troop, up to 4 scouts, regardless of district, shall be confirmed. All other applicants shall remain waitlisted.
 - (c) From May 27th through May 31st, 2008, remaining scouts from each troop, up to 6 scouts per troop, regardless of district, shall be confirmed. All other applicants shall remain waitlisted.
 - (d) After June 2nd, 2008, all remaining spots will be filled from the waiting list and new applications received, regardless of troop and district.
5. Parents/family members may only submit in-person applications for pre-registration for their son(s) and one other nonfamily member. Any person submitting more than one application shall identify the order in which the applications are being submitted for time-stamping purposes.
6. Those applicants who have been confirmed will be directed to national web site to complete their enrollment process. There is a \$10 nonrefundable fee that must be paid when an individual completes their online enrollment. Individuals will then be directed to print a confirmation and send it to the council with an additional nonrefundable \$100 deposit. Selection for the Jamboree will be based strictly on the council's pre-registration process. Enrolling via the on-line system at the National Web Site will not change a scout's priority.
7. Jamboree troops will be formed in the Spring of 2009 and troops will begin their meetings in preparation for the jamboree experience.

Policy Statement: Selection of Adult Leaders to fill our council contingent to the 2010 National Scout Jamboree

Our council allocation is five troops consisting of 36 scouts and four adult leaders for a total of 180 scouts and 20 adult leaders.

The Council Jamboree Committee is responsible for selecting the best qualified adults to assume leadership positions in our council contingent troops attending the jamboree. Registered Scouters interested in assuming a jamboree troop leadership position should complete their application using the online system at the national web site no later than November 1st, 2008. Note: there is no pre-registration process in place for adult Scouters seeking troop leader positions in our council contingent.

There is a \$10 nonrefundable fee that must be paid when an individual completes their online enrollment. Individuals will then be directed to print a confirmation and send it to the council with a \$100 deposit. The \$100 deposit will be refunded if the applicant is not selected as a jamboree troop leader.

After November 1st, 2008, troop leadership candidates will be provided with a prescreening questionnaire. Candidates shall complete the questionnaire and return it to Bob Morris at the council service center by November 21st, 2008.

Candidates will be interviewed by the council jamboree committee between December 1st, 2008 and January 12th, 2009. Selection decisions will be made by the end of January 2009 and all applicants shall be advised of their standing. Troop leaders that have selected will then join the council jamboree committee and attend monthly meetings beginning in February 2009.
