There is a longstanding policy that there shall be no visiting troops or Scouters of the Boy Scouts of America in living quarters adjacent to the jamboree area. This means no military facilities or local council camps within 50 miles of the jamboree site will be available to visiting troops for living purposes.

Jamboree housing and food requests will be handled by the Jamboree Department. Volunteers contacting any military installation within a 50-mile radius of Fort A.P. Hill will be referred to their local council for assistance.

FAPH personnel and any military installation within a 50-mile radius of Fort A.P. Hill are asked to refer requests for housing or meals from jamboree attendees or visitors to their local BSA council.
